Location: Eureka Township, MN. Hwy 35 south to Co. Rd. 70 (McStop in Lakeville). East 3 mi to Cedar Ave (Co Rd 23). South past Airlake Airport 3 miles to 250th. Parking in Eureka Town Hall parking lot.

Time: Registration 5:30 to 6:45 pm. First racer starts at 7:00. Racers start in registration order and at 30-second intervals.

Course Description: Flat 8 mi total 'T' course. Start at 250th n Cedar Ave. West to Co Rd. 9 (Dodd Blvd). Turn around and proceed to Highview Ave. Down and back on Highview Ave. Return to 250th and back to Eureka Town Hall. Course open to auto traffic, observe all traffic rules.

Warm-up up and down Cedar Ave from 250th. A shoulder exists both north and south on Cedar Ave.

Dates: June 1, June 15, June 29, July 13, July 27, August 10

Held under USA Cycling permit. All USA Cycling rules apply – Approved helmets, no mangled numbers. Racers **MUST** show their USA Cycling road racing license (or permit to race) or purchase a USA Cycling license at registration.

Entry fee: \$15. Juniors \$5/event.

Categories/Prizes: Prizes awarded for fastest 5 times over series

Open male: \$220 cash or prizes to top 3 series winners

Stock bike male: \$170 cash or prizes to top 3 series winners

Masters 35+ male: \$170 cash or prizes to top 3 series winners

Masters 50+ male: \$150 cash or prizes to top 3 series winners

Masters 60+ male: \$120 cash or prizes to top 3 series winners

Open female: \$220 cash or prizes to top 3 series winners

Stock bike female: \$170 cash or prizes to top 3 series winners
